Sierra is the daughter of Deb and Jamie Williamson of Sherburn. She is a student at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis.

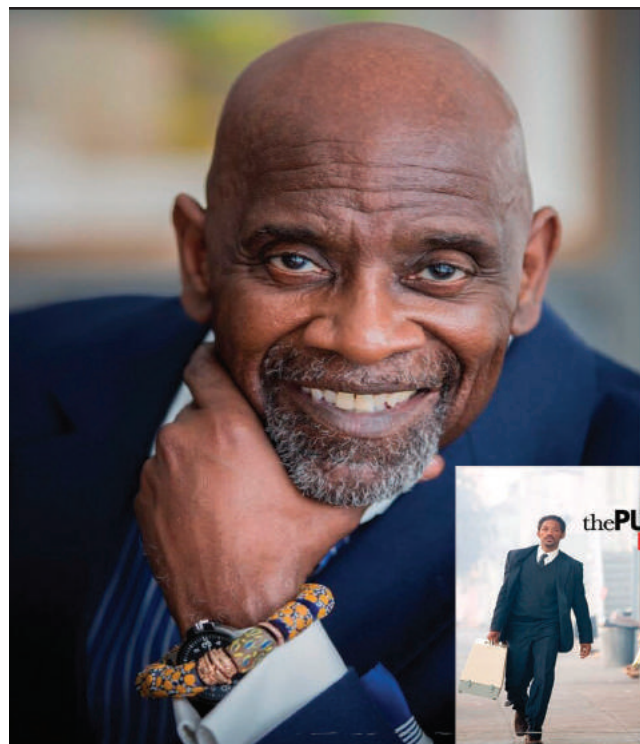

Butterfield native trains the future of the Navy

Sailors are some of the most highly-trained people on the planet, according to Navy officials, and this training requires highly-dedicated recruit division commanders.

At Recruit Training Command, otherwise known as "boot camp," hard-charging Navy professionals, guides recruits in the transformation process, from civilians, into disciplined, qualified U.S. Navy sailors.

Senior Chief Petty Officer Jessica Douglas, a native of Butterfield, Minnesota, is a recruit division commander at RTC, who trains and mentors the future of the fleet.

"What I enjoy most about training recruits is seeing them transformed into the best version of themselves," Douglas said.

regardless of how others treat you."

Douglas plays an important role in America's focus on rebuilding military readiness, strengthening alliances and reforming business practices in support of National Defense Strategy.

"Our priorities center on

community and career, Douglas is most proud of receiving her chief anchors.

"My anchors are by far my greatest reward I've received in the Navy," Douglas said. "I'm most proud of this accomplishment because I'm blessed to wear these anchors every day."

Serving in the Navy is a continuing tradition of military service for Douglas, who has military ties with family members who have previously served. Douglas is honored to carry on the family tradition.

"My grandfather was a Marine, my great uncle served in the Army and I have several cousins in the National Guard," Douglas said. "I'm honored to carry the family torch serving our country."

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Commissioners (the "Board") of Martin County, Minnesota (the "County"), will hold a public hearing at a meeting of the County Board beginning at 10:00 a.m., on **Tuesday, September 3, 2019**, to be held at the at the Martin County Courthouse 201 Lake Avenue, Fairmont, Minnesota, on the request of CHS, Inc. (the "Company"), in connection with the proposed construction of new facilities and the expansion of the existing facilities located at 1833 130th Street, Fairmont, Minnesota, and to grant an abatement to the Company of property taxes to be levied by the County on Parcel ID No. 23.039.0072, in the City of Fairmont (the "Property"). The total amount of the taxes proposed to be abated by the County on the Property for the years 2022 through 2031 is estimated to be not more than \$423,930. The Board of Commissioners will consider granting a property tax abatement, which is a business subsidy, in response to the request.

Information about the proposed business subsidy will be on file and available for public inspection at the office of the County Coordinator's Office at the Martin County Courthouse.

A person with residence in or the owner of taxable property in the granting jurisdiction may file a written complaint with the County if the County fails to comply with Sections 116J.993 to 116J.995, and no action may be filed against the County for the failure to comply unless a written complaint is filed.

Setting a price for your home

What is your home worth? A common real estate axiom is that your house is worth, "what someone will pay for it!" So, what would someone pay for your home? Basically, buyers expect to pay roughly what similar homes have recently sold for in the area.

There are many factors that affect pricing, the first being...you guessed it...

location!!! Although realtors themselves cannot legally recommend or avoid certain areas, most buyers do have an idea already of where they want to live. And obviously, some locations, such as waterfront or on a golf course, are worth more to people who are looking for these situations.

In addition, the style of the home, size, and

condition are also important when setting a price, and features such as extra garage space, fireplaces, screened porches, and high-end fixtures, also add desirability and value.

Most realtors subscribe to a computerized MLS (multiple listing service), which is constantly updated, listing details and descriptions of homes for sale and homes that have

sold or expired. This information, coupled with a tour by in-house agents for opinions, is used for comparison with other homes that are for sale or have sold recently. Using this information, and other criteria, your realtor will then prepare a Comparative Market Analysis for a suggested price range.

It is difficult for some sellers to accept that their original purchase price, plus the cost of improvements they have made, generally don't have too much bearing when setting a home's selling price; current market trends and comparable home prices

are more important. Others feel the best practice is to price their home high and plan to take less. However, this can scare off potential buyers, and you may miss out on others looking in a slightly lower price range.

The more reasonable your price, the more buyers you could attract, and the quicker your home could sell. A high price could mean that it sits on the Multiple Listing Service for a long time, thus becoming a "stale listing" to those who check the MLS regularly - it may make people wonder if something is wrong with

the home!

Most homes that are sold with a mortgage will undergo an appraisal ordered by the lender. Thus, if overpriced, the appraisal will come back with a lower value, leaving the buyer to either make up the difference, to withdraw from the sale (if they have a Financing Contingency), or to negotiate a new price with the seller.

Realtors can't tell you how much to list for, but will suggest a range of price, basing our opinion on research and experience, so pricing a home is partly an art, and partly a science!

Almond Chocolate Cake:

6 eggs, separated
2 1/2 cups blanched almonds, toasted
2 tablespoons plus 1 1/4 cups sugar, divided
1/2 cup butter, softened
3 squares (1 oz. each) semi sweet chocolate, grated
1/4 cup brewed espresso
2 tablespoons baking cocoa
1 tablespoons orange juice
1 tablespoons instant espresso granules
1 tsp. vanilla extract

Place egg whites in a small mixing bowl. Let stand at room temperature for 30 minutes. Meanwhile, in a food processor combine almonds and 2 tablespoons sugar; cover and process until ground. Set aside.

In a large bowl, cream butter and remaining sugar until light and fluffy. Add egg yolks, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in chocolate, espresso, cocoa, orange juice and espresso granules, vanilla and reserved almond mixture. Beat reserved egg whites on high until stiff peaks form. Fold egg whites into the batter. Pour into a greased 9-inch spring form pan. Place pan on a baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 42-48 minutes or until cake springs back when lightly touched. Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Carefully run a knife around edge of pan to loosen, cool completely. Garnish with confection sugar, chocolate curls and coffee beans if desired. I served with whipped topping or ice cream.

"Grandchild" Scam Phone Call

Early last week we received a phone call and we could hear a grandchild crying and asking for our help to get them out of jail. We asked if this was "name" (our grandchild) and the answer was yes and went on to say only one phone call was allowed. We were instructed to bring \$2,000 right away so the child could be released. We asked if we could come to the jail and talk to the arresting officer.

We were told it was either "Mr. Brooks" or "Mr. Green". "Officer" Green answered and said our grandchild was under a gag order and only had one call and that ours was the only call. He said he was from the State Police. I asked for his badge number, which he gave. He said he was not the arresting officer.

We said we could come to the jail and he said, "No, we do not have a cash box here. You will have to go through 'bail' department." We asked for details of the arrest. He said our grandchild was with a friend in a car that neither one owned. The friend blew through a stop sign so the officer stopped them. There were drugs in the vehicle. Then he told us the amount of bail was \$4,000. We told him we

did not have that kind of money readily available. He said to go to the bank and get a "cash advance". I pushed for more details of the arrest and he said since he was not the arresting officer, he would have to get the details and put us on hold.

In the meantime, while I was on the phone waiting, my husband called our grandchild at work and talked to our grandchild. By then I was disconnected from the "hold" call. I quickly called the Martin County Law Enforcement Center and notified them of the call. They said it was a SCAM and not to follow through. She also said to tell our friends and relatives about this miserable phone scam.

These two people were very pushy. The "grandchild" was crying and asking for help from us right away. The "officer" became very brusque and insistent. We thought it was strange the officers were identified as "Mr." and the child's voice didn't sound quite right. Another red flag was the amount of bail increasing from \$2,000 to \$4,000.
